Applicant must be a student of a teacher who is an active member of the Riverside MTAC Applicant must have studied with present teacher since the Fall Term, <b>2020.</b> Student applicant <u>may not</u> perform a piece that he or she has previously performed at a Riverside Young Pianists' Competition. Former First Place Winners are not eligible to participate in the same category.

REPERTOIRE      Elementary I & II    Two pieces only from two different periods. Maximum Time: 5 minutes.  
Junior High      Two pieces only from two different periods. Maximum Time: 10 minutes.  
High School I & II    Two pieces only from two different periods. Maximum Time: 12 minutes.

JUDGING      Applicants must provide original copies of their music for the judges. Students presenting photocopies will be disqualified.  
All music must be performed by memory.  
The decision of the judges is final. Judges reserve the right to not award a prize if they feel an acceptable level of performance is not reached.
